Grangemouth: Kirk of the Holy Rood finding aid

Kirk of the Holy Rood was erected as part of the church extension movement of the Church of Scotland in 1961 and granted full status in 1971. The first minister, Rev Iain Campbell, was appointed by the Church Extension Committee of the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland and inducted on 26 April 1961.

The Church of Scotland kirk session for Grangemouth Kirk of the Holy Rood sat within the presbytery of Linlithgow and Falkirk and from 1976 in the presbytery of Falkirk.

The building was dedicated on 28th June 1963.
