Rotaract Club of Falkirk finding aid

Rotaract is Rotary International's service club program for young adults ages 18-30, and was officially inaugurated during January 1968 with the first club opening in March 1968. By 2006 there were more than 7,600 Rotaract clubs in more than 158 countries, with an estimated membership of more than 176,000. Clubs undertake projects of benefit to the community and also have a programme of social meetings. Each club is sponsored by a Rotary Club.

Falkirk Rotaract Club was formed in 1976 and closed in 1996.
